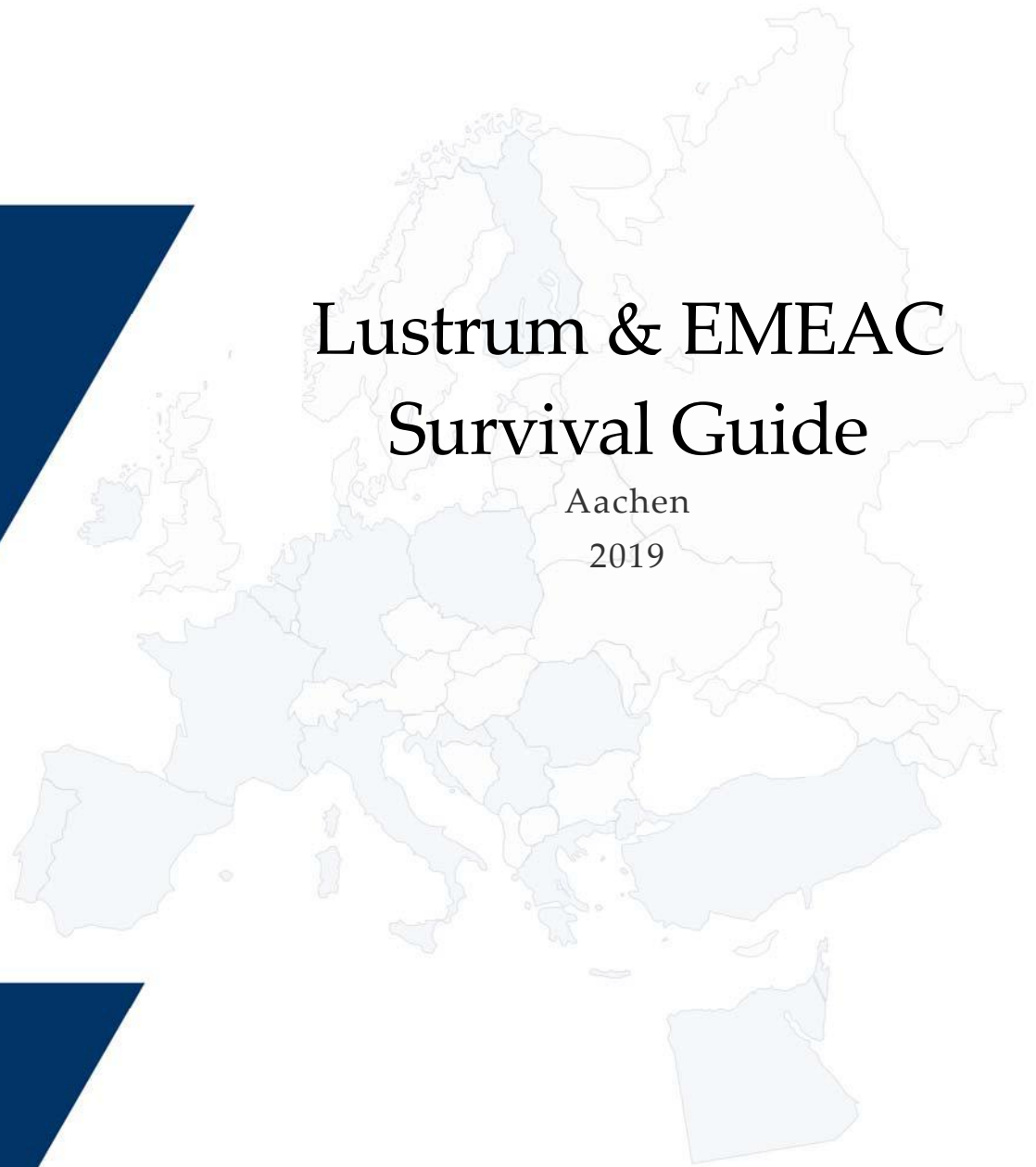

Welcome back to Aachen, a place where EUROAVIA was founded!

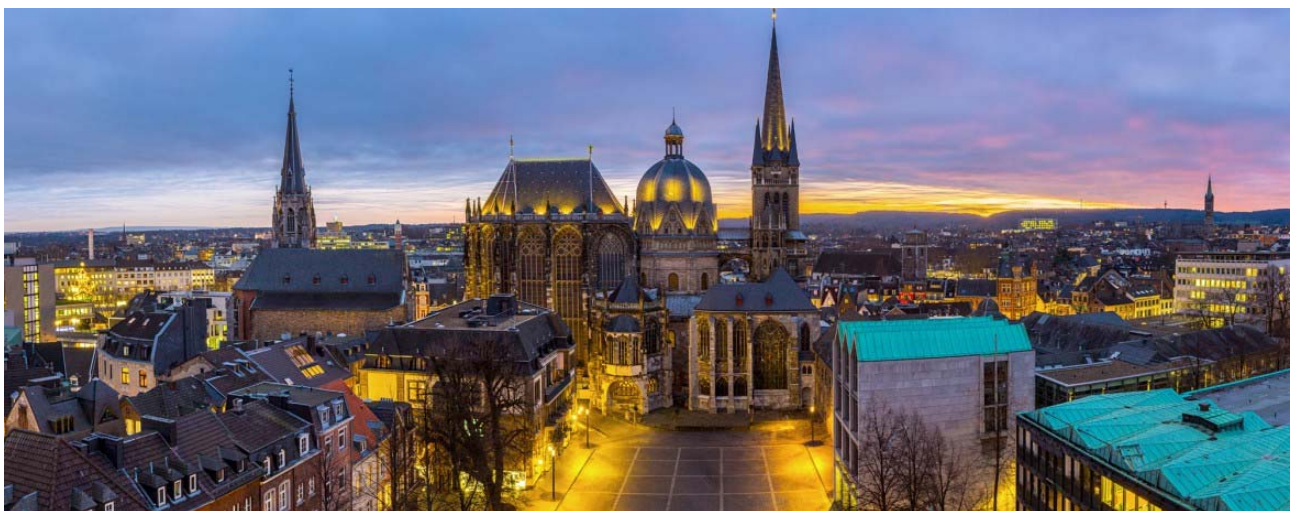

## 4 General Information

### Power:

### Lunches and dinners:

Breakfast for both events will be served at the hostel. For the Lustrum, lunch will be served at the spot. Gala dinner will take place at Aposto, a restaurant close to Aachen city centre. From the 5th to the 10th (EMEAC) lunch will take place at different locals around Aachen. There will be two meal options every day, for vegetarians as well. The dinner will be arranged in a similar manner.

### Transportation in Aachen:

Aachen is small enough that you can get everywhere on foot. If you however absolutely need a transport, you can use buses. Here is the app, which will help you navigate around Aachen. This app can also be used to find a suitable connection to one of the airports, which are close to Aachen.

### Weather:

May is rather warm (20 to 30 degrees) in Aachen but evenings can be colder, so bring something warmer to wear in the evening. Just in case it is rainy, you should bring some umbrella or jacket that you can wear in this case.

**Arriving in Aachen:**

Aachen has one airport and it shares it with Maastricht, hence the name Aachen-Maastricht airport. This is the closest one but there are not many flights flying there and they might be more expensive.

Other than that there are many airports relatively close to Aachen and easy to reach. Cologne, Düsseldorf, Eindhoven and Brussels are some of them. Cologne is the closest one. All of these airports are connected with Aachen via train or FlixBus. AS Aachen will try to organise to pick you up at the airport itself, but this might not be possible for some participants. Depending on the city you arrive at, cost of travelling to Aachen may vary but they will usually be between 10 and 20 Euros.

## 5 Lustrum

Lustrum participants will stay at A&O Hauptbahnhof hostel, which is very close to the main train station. The exact address of the hostel is A&O Hostel Hauptbahnhof, Hackländerstraße 5, 52074 Aachen.

For participants arriving on 3<sup>rd</sup> of May we will organise a welcome dinner at one of Aachen’s restaurants. Lustrum itself takes place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> of May in Couvenhalle, a venue in the centre of Aachen. Gala dinner will take place in the atrium of Aposto, a restaurant close to the city centre. The closing ceremony will also take place there. After the dinner those participants who are willing to party will be presented with such possibilities and organisers will likely join. The 5<sup>th</sup> of May will have no specified agenda. Alumni and participants, which aren’t staying for EMEAC will receive a city tour. The rest can choose to do so as well or participate in some other activity, which AS will organise.

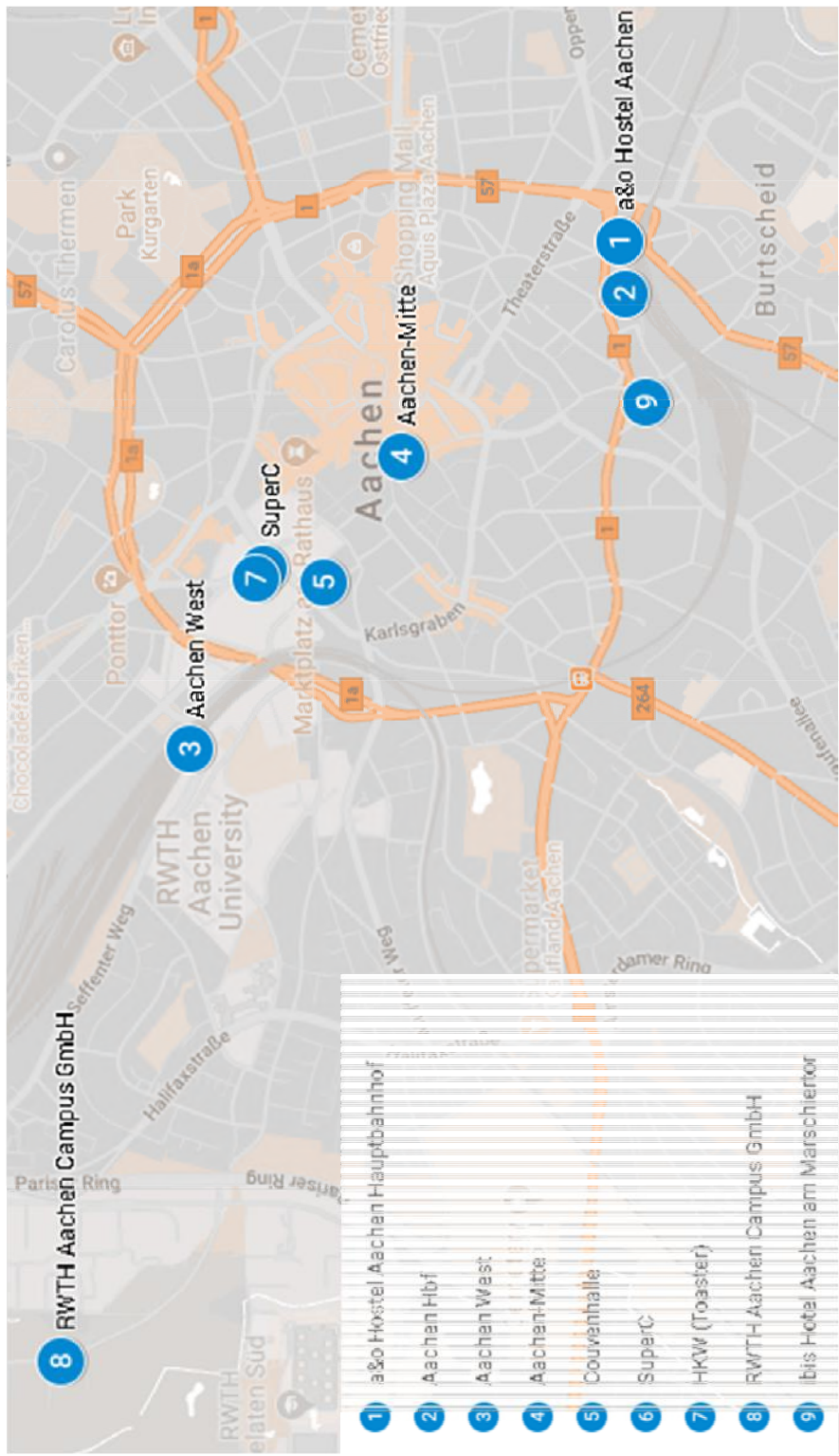
